- 2) Troops should provide a *Scenario Patrol* (approximately 3-5 Scouts). Scenarios must consist of a beach-themed disaster (think fun & crazy). Please contact the T73 Staff Leadership to make arrangements to support this program. Bring any props needed to make the scenario realistic; proper stage makeup can be provided before the event.
